## Fruit of the Spirit: Peace

#### **PRELUDE**

**WORSHIP THEME:** Advent looks to the past to prepare us for the future. As we prepare to celebrate Christ's First Advent when He became incarnate as man, we review the promises of God as we prepare for Christ's Second and Final Advent.

"Dining on the Fruit of Spirit." Between Midweek Advent and Midweek Lenten services we are exploring 9 characteristics that make up the Fruit of the Holy Spirit mentioned in Galatians 5:22-23. These are how the Holy Spirit is working in us to be more like Jesus. Tonight, you will receive a fruit tree and a piece of fruit to put on that tree.

This week we explore the Holy Spirit's Fruit of Peace. Jesus' Peace is more than an absence of conflict with an adversary. It is an inner quality that only the Holy Spirit can give. This way our faith can function in a healthy way when it comes to our inner-being and how we address the challenges of our life. God bless you with more of His peace as you feed on God's Word tonight.


