

#### **Irish Beef Stew**

#### **INGREDIENTS**

- · 3 tbsp. extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 lbs. braising steak or stew meat, cubed into 1" pieces
- · Salt & Freshly ground black pepper
- · 1 yellow onion, chopped
- · 2 medium carrots, peeled and cut into rounds
- · 2 stalks celery, chopped
- · 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 3 medium russet potatoes, peeled and cut into large chunks
- 4 cups low-sodium beef stock
- 1 (16 oz,) bottle Guinness
- · 2 tsp. fresh thyme
- · Freshly chopped parsley, for serving

#### DIRECTIONS

- 1. In a large Dutch oven over medium heat, heat 2 tablespoons oil.

  Season beef with salt and pepper, then add to pot and cook on all sides until seared, 10 minutes, working in batches if necessary.

  Transfer beef to a plate.
- 2. In same pot, add remaining tablespoon oil and cook onion, carrots, and celery until soft, 5 minutes. Season with salt and pepper. Add garlic and cook until fragrant, 1 minute.
- 3. Add beef back to Dutch oven, then add potatoes, stock, beer, and thyme. Bring to a boil, then reduce heat to a simmer. Season with salt and pepper. Cover and let simmer until beef and potatoes are tender, 30 minutes.
- 4. Garnish with parsley before serving.
